Westside Board of Education Announces New Superintendent



At the Westside Board of Education meeting on Monday February 6, 2012, Board Members voted to appoint Dr. Blane McCann as the District's ninth Superintendent. Dr. McCann will succeed Ms. Jacquie Estee, who after 40 years with Westside Community Schools, including 4 years of service as Superintendent, will retire at the end of this school year.

Westside Board President Kathy Bradley said, "We could not have made a more outstanding choice. Blane is a visionary leader who respects the importance of school culture and is strongly student-centered. With 31 years of experience as a teacher, building and central office administrator, and superintendent, Blane has the academic and professional expertise to successfully guide Westside into the future." Ms. Estee added, "In the coming months, I look forward to working closely with Blane to ensure a smooth leader-

ship transition as he meets with students, staff, and community members."

Dr. McCann is a career educator. In 1981, he earned his Bachelor of Science degree in secondary social studies education from Miami University in Oxford, Ohio, where he was also a member of the varsity baseball team. Upon obtaining his bachelor's degree, Dr. McCann worked as a high school and middle school social studies teacher at school districts in Florida and Iowa, respectively. In 1983, Dr. McCann earned his Masters in Educational Administration and Supervision from the University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill.

In 1987, Dr. McCann went to work as an administrator for the Kenosha Unified School District, in Kenosha, Wisconsin. He served as an assistant principal and principal before transitioning to his role as Executive Director of K-8 Instruction. During his tenure as executive director, Dr. McCann supervised 24 elementary schools, 6 middle schools, the K-12 special education and guidance programs, along with several federal programs.

In 2000, he earned his Doctorate of Philosophy (Ph.D.) in Educational Policy and Leadership from Marquette University in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. In 2003, Dr. McCann became the Superintendent of the School District of Shorewood in Shorewood, Wisconsin (a Milwaukee suburb).

As leader of the 2,000 student school district, Dr. McCann managed eight years of budget shortfalls while minimizing impact in the classroom, oversaw the passage of capital improvement and retirement fund referendums totaling \$23.2 million, reversed diminishing enrollment trends by successfully marketing schools to attract new resident students, and collaborated with a Milwaukee-area superintendent group to advocate for public education in the Wisconsin Legislature. Both U.S. News and World Report and Newsweek magazines have named Shorewood High School as being among the best high schools in the United States.

Dr. McCann has been involved in numerous professional organizations throughout his career, including the American Association of School Administrators, the Wisconsin Association of School District Administrators, the Kenosha School Administrators Association, the Kenosha County Easter Seals Board of Directors, Rotary International, the National Staff Development Council, the National Middle School Association, and Phi Delta Kappan.

Dr. McCann has been married for 31 years to his wife Marie. They have five children, Nick (29), Ted (27), Monica (25), Will (22), and Audrey (13).

Bob Saffer – 1961

Bob Saffer was a two-sport athlete at Westside High School. He was a three-year letter winner in both basketball and golf at Westside High School. Even though Bob was a three-year starter in basketball, it was the golf course where Bob excelled. In 1959, as sophomore, Bob was an individual state champion shooting a 71. The boys' golf team also won the state championship that year. The next year, Bob and the Westside golf team were state runner-ups. During his senior year, the golf team finished 6th at state. After high school, Bob took his talents to the University of Arizona for 2 years and then attended the University Nebraska his junior and senior years. After a successful business career, Bob entered the golf world again. In 1997, he became a Class A PGA golf professional. He is considered one of the best teaching pros in Nebraska and was named 2009 PGA Teacher of the Year. In 2010, Bob was invited by the PGA National Convention to showcase his talents in teaching golf. What makes this an even more remarkable story is that Bob is the oldest PGA Class A Professional in the United States. Bob is married to his wife Gayle and has 2 daughters, Julie and Leighann and seven grandchildren.

Allan Bach - 1967

Allan Bach was a football and wrestling standout at Westside High School. In 1966, he was the starting quarterback for the mythical state championship football team. As a wrestler he lettered 3 times and was a state runner-up in 1966. In 1967 he was a state champion at 127 pounds. After a successful high school career, Allan attended the University of Iowa and lettered in wrestling in 1968. Allan excelled in the classroom and went on to become an orthopedic surgeon. He attended the University of Nebraska Medical School and completed his orthopedic residency at the University of Washington, where he was on the faculty for 18 years. During that time, Allan won 2 outstanding teaching awards as a Clinical Professor of Orthopedics. He was also named Red Cross Outstanding Volunteer in 2011 for his work in Haiti. Allan has spent many other hours volunteering and teaching in Vietnam, Uganda, and

Rwanda. One of Allan's major life experiences has been mountain climbing. He has climbed mountains in Asia, (Gasherbrum II,) Africa, (Mt. Elgon) Europe, (Monta Rosa) North America (Denali & Mr. Ranier) and South America. Allan is married to his wife Carol and has two sons, David and Mike.

Dan Wingard - 1981

Dan Wingard was a three-sport star while at Westside High School. He earned letters in football, basketball and track. In 1980, Dan was the quarterback and team captain on the Westside football team that went 10 – 2 before losing in the state semi-finals. He was a member of the 1980 state championship basketball team and qualified and placed in two events at the state track meet. In 1981, he was named B'nai B'rith Athlete of the Year, Shrine Bowl Most Valuable Player – Offense and kicked a Shrine Bowl Record 41 yard field goal at the Shrine football game. After high school, Dan took his talents to the University of Nebraska. Dan participated on 3 football teams that were Big Eight Champions from 1983 to 1985. Dan was a second team all Big Eight punter in 1985 and once averaged 54 yard/punt in a game vs. Missouri in 1985. At the end of the 1985 season, Dan was ranked 7th nationally in net punting and 11th nationally in punting with 42-yard average. In 1988, Dan joined the military and went to flight school at Williams AFB, Chandler, AZ graduating in June of 1989. Dan has logged numerous combat hours and participated in Operation Northern Watch and Southern Watch, (no-fly zone enforcement) Kosovo, Iraqi Freedom, Enduring Freedom, and most recently Unified Protector (Libya). Additionally, he has participated in numerous Humanitarian Aid missions. He has attained the rank of Lieutenant Colonel and is Director of Operations for the 173rd Air Refueling Squadron for the Nebraska Air National Guard. His most enjoyable moment in flying was November 27, 2009, commanding the National Anthem Flyover for the Nebraska/Colorado football game. He was introduced on the field in the third quarter and revealed his 1985 jersey from under his flight suit, eliciting a standing ovation and deafening roar from the 85,000 in attendance. Dan and his wife Merrille, daughter Dani (17) and son Andrew (15) reside in Arvada, Co.

Tony Schragger - 1983

Tony was a baseball and basketball standout at Westside High School. He was a 2-time letter winner in basketball and three-time letter winner in baseball. He was captain and leading scorer for the 1995 Westside basketball team. In baseball, Tony was All-State in 1994 and 1995 and captain of the 1995 All-State baseball team. He was also named High School Coaches Baseball All-American 1995, American Legion Baseball Player of the Year 1995, B'nai, B'rith Male Athlete of the Year 1985, and was a member of the Gold Medal Junior Team USA Baseball 1995. After high school, Tony took his baseball talents to Yale University and Stanford University. He was the starting second baseman for Stanford from 1997 to 1998. He was also a Cape Code All-Star in 1997. After college, the Chicago Cubs drafted Tony in the 6th round. He went on to play 9 years of professional baseball. He ended his pro baseball career in 2006 for the Florida Marlin (AAA) club. Today, he is a partner for Battle Sports Science. Tony is the son of Harley and Beth Schragger.

Beth Williams Leach - 1998

Beth was a standout swimmer and soccer player while at Westside High School. She was a three-time letter winner in soccer and a four-time letter winner in swimming. She is the current school record holder in the 200 individual medley and the 100 butterfly. She also was a Junior Nationals Qualifier and was named Metro Female Swimmer of the Year in 1995 and 1996. In her years at state meet, she accrued 7 state medals. She won back-to-back gold medals in the 100 butterfly in 1995 and 1996. After her successful high school career, she took her swimming talents to Rice University. She lettered 4 times at Rice in swimming and even lettered her senior year in soccer. She was a very successful swimmer at Rice, earning many honors. Beth was a 5X NCAA provisional qualifier, a Western Athletic Conference Champion in the 200 IM, a Rice University school record holder in the 100-breast stroke and was a 2000 Olympic Trials qualifier. Beth is currently an English teacher at Westside High School. She is married to Grant Leach and they have a one-year-old daughter, Whitney.

Ann Royle - Coach

Ann was a pioneer for coaching women's sports at Westside High School. Ann spent over 30 years at Westside, teaching business and coaching volleyball and track. In 1971, she started the volleyball program on an intramural basis and then started coaching the team the following season. During that time, she garnered over 400 wins and coached her teams to 15 state tournament appearances. She also coached 3 metro championship teams. As a pioneer for women's sports in the state of Nebraska, she played in a college volleyball triangular which is thought to be one of the first women's collegiate athletic events played in Nebraska. Ann has coached over 500 student athletes during her coaching tenure. Her philosophy was "It is not about wins and losses, but what you give and bring to your team and game, by always finding a way to dig deep." She is the second oldest of 8 siblings - 5 sisters and 2 brothers. Nineteen nieces and nephews and 20 great nieces and nephews surround Ann.

President's Corner

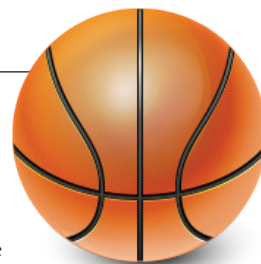
Dear Fellow Alumni,

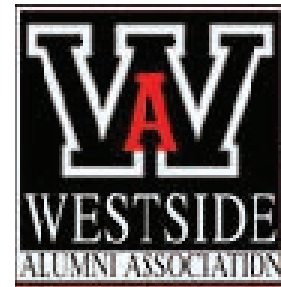

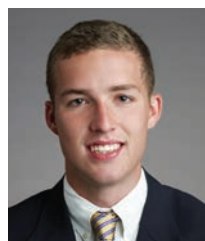

The Vic Porter Scholarship

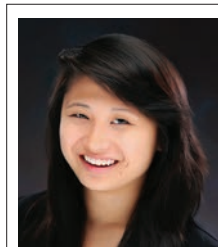
The Vic Porter Scholarship is awarded annually to a Westside Senior Girl's Basketball Player who best exemplifies the disciplined, unselfish,
